


Background & Aims

Project A3.5 is part of the National Educational Panel Study (NEPS), which is organized as a research consortium with the MZES being one of its members.

The overall aim of NEPS is to collect longitudinal data on the development of competencies, educational processes, educational decisions, and returns to education throughout the life span.

Together with colleagues at Humboldt University and Leibniz Institute for Educational Trajectories (LIfBi) in Bamberg, we address the acquisition of education across the life span against a migration background. To this end, we have developed migrant-specific instruments that are now implemented across all the six NEPS cohorts.
