

Eligible Authors:

All researchers involved formally in either CONNEX or NEWGOV are eligible to be authors of **EUROGOV** papers.

Subject to sufficient resources, researchers external to both networks, but participating in workshops or conferences directly related to one of the networks are also entitled to submit to the working paper series upon invitation by a Research Group Coordinator.

Quality:

- each paper is refereed by an internationally renowned scholar (double-blind system)

Visibility:

- All papers are available at an online web interface
- The average paper download of EUROGOV papers per month is 138
- The list of EUROGOV subscribers consists of over 740 people
